Payments (Students must confirm with their host school/university that Smith is responsible for all tuition, room and board expenses)	
Tuition Deposit Required?	No
Accommodation Deposit Covered by Smith?	Yes, covered by Smith. In the interest of time deposit should be paid by the student and reimbursed. Contact Study Abroad Coordinator for refund.
Tuition:	Tuition invoicing is sent directly to Smith
Accommodation:	Students must forward on the email they receive from UCL regarding accommodation payments. Student must submit UCL user name and password to the Study Abroad Coordinator so that payments can be processed online.
Accommodation Expectations:	Not guaranteed. Must apply for university-affiliated housing by posted deadline. Students should choose "mid-range" priced accommodation - not the most expensive and not the cheapest, but somewhere in between. Recommendations are Ifor Evans Hall, Ramsey Hall, and any mid range student house. Housing options are listed online at http://www.ucl.ac.uk/prospective-students/accommodation/residences In most cases, mid-range will be rooms in flats where you may or may not have your own bathroom (aka: en suite) and where you'll have to cook for yourself (aka: self-catered).
Accommodation Application Deadline at University College London:	Contact UCL for spring accommodation information
Visa:	All students applying directly to host schools/universities will be required to obtain their own visa. It is very important that students begin this process early, as it may take a several months to obtain. This is especially true for International Students.
